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Starting September 29, 2021, Medi-Cal providers can apply for additional Provider Relief Fund (PRF) Phase 4 and American Rescue Plan (ARP) Rural payments. On September 10, 2021, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) announced the availability of \$25.5 billion in new funding for health care providers affected by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Phase 4 General Distribution — \$17 billion based on providers' lost revenues and changes in operating expenses from July 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021.

- To promote equity and to support providers with the most need, HRSA will:
 - * Reimburse a higher percentage of lost revenues and expenses for smaller providers as compared to larger providers.
 - * Provide "bonus" payments based on the amount of services they provide to Medicaid, CHIP, and Medicare patients, priced at the generally higher Medicare rates.
- American Rescue Plan (ARP) Rural \$8.5 billion based on the amount of services
 providers furnish to Medicaid/CHIP and Medicare members living in Federal Office of
 Rural Health Policy (FORHP)-defined rural areas.
 - To promote equity, HRSA will price payments at the generally higher Medicare rates for Medicaid/CHIP patients

Providers facing challenges from recent natural disasters and the Delta variant will have a **final 60-day grace period** to come into compliance with their <u>PRF Reporting Requirements</u> if they fail to meet the deadline on September 30, 2021.
