## Modified Adjudication Reason Code 013, and New Codes 013C, 013D, and 013E

Effective June 13, 2013, Adjudication Reason Code (ARC) 013 will be updated and ARCs 013C, 013D, and 013E will be added to the system.

### *ARC 013 Modified*

ARC 013 currently reads as follows:

**013** Procedure requires an operative report including the hospital time for payment.

After June 13, ARC 013 will read as follows:

**013** Procedure requires an operative report or anesthesia record with the actual time indicated.

### *New ARCs 013C, 013D, and 013E*

The following ARCs below will be effective on June 13, 2013. These ARCs will be effective for the following procedures:

- D9220 (Deep Sedation/General Anesthesia – First 30 Minutes)
- D9221 (Deep Sedation/General Anesthesia – Each Additional 15 Minutes)
- D9241 (Intravenous Conscious Sedation/Analgesia – First 30 Minutes)
- D9242 (Intravenous Conscious Sedation/Analgesia – Each Additional 15 Minutes)

### ARC 013C

ARC 013C reads as follows:

- 013C** The anesthesia record must be signed by the rendering provider and the rendering provider's name and permit number must be printed and legible.

For Procedures D9220, D9221, D9241, and D9242, an Anesthesia Record must be submitted with the request for payment and must be signed by the enrolled provider performing the analgesia procedure. The provider name and permit number **must** be printed and legible. If the Anesthesia Record is **not** submitted, or any of the required information is not indicated, then the procedure will be **denied**.

### ARC 013D

ARC 013D reads as follows:

- 013D** The treating provider name on the anesthesia record does not coincide with the Rendering Provider Number (NPI) in field 33 on the claim.

For Procedures D9220, D9221, D9241, and D9242, the provider name on the anesthesia record **must** coincide with the rendering number in field 33 on the claim for payment. If they do not match, then the procedure will be **denied**.

### ARC 013E

ARC 013E reads as follows:

- 013E** The treating provider performing the analgesia procedure must have a valid permit from the DBC and the permit number must be on file with Denti-Cal.

For Procedures D9220, D9221, D9241, and D9242, the rendering provider performing the general anesthesia / intravenous conscious sedation/analgesia **must** have a valid permit from the Dental Board of California (DBC) and the permit number must be on file with Denti-Cal. When there is not a valid/current permit on file for the rendering provider, the procedure will be **denied**.
